Naso (Num 5:5-10)

5 ADONAI spoke to Moses saying,

6 "Say to *Bnei-Yisrael*: Whenever a man or woman commits any sins against any person, thus breaking faith with *ADONAI*, that soul bears guilt.

7 That person is to confess the sin he has committed, make full restitution for his wrong, add one fifth to it and give it to the one he wronged.

2 Now there was a certain man from Zorah, from a Danite clan, whose name was Manoah. His wife was barren and bore no children.

3 Then the angel of Adonai appeared to the woman and said to her, "Behold now, you are barren and have not borne children, but you will conceive and bear a son.

- Naso (Acts 9:1-18)
- 1 Now Saul, still breathing out threats and murder against the Lord's disciples, went to the *kohen gadol*.
- 2 He requested letters of introduction from him to the synagogues in Damascus, so that if he found any men or women belonging to the Way, he might bring them as prisoners to Jerusalem.
- 3 As he was traveling, approaching Damascus, suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him.

- 4 Falling to the ground, he heard a voice saying to him, "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me?"
- 5 "Who are You, Lord?" Saul said. "I am *Yeshua*—whom you are persecuting.

6 But get up and go into the city, and you will be told what you must do."





7 The men travelling with him stood speechless, hearing the voice but seeing no one.

8 Saul got up from the ground — but opening his eyes, he could see nothing. They led him by the hand and brought him into Damascus.

9 For three days he could not see, and he did not eat or drink.

10 Now there was a disciple named Ananias in Damascus. The Lord said to him, "Ananias." He said, "Here I am, Lord."

11 The Lord said to him, "Get up and go to the street named Straight, and ask in the house of Judah for someone from Tarsus named Saul. For look, he is praying;

12 and in a vision he has seen a man named Ananias coming in and laying his hands on him, so that he might regain his sight."





13 But Ananias answered, "Lord, I have heard from many about this man—how much harm he has done to your *kedoshim* in Jerusalem.

14 And here he has authority from the ruling *kohanim* to tie up all who call on Your name."

15 But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a choice instrument to carry My name before nations and kings and *Bnei-Yisrael*.

16 For I will show him how much he must suffer for My name's sake."

17 So Ananias left and entered into the house. Laying hands on Saul, he said, "Brother Saul, the Lord—Yeshua, the One who appeared to you on the road by which you were coming—has sent me, so that you might regain your sight and be filled with the Ruach ha-Kodesh."

18 Immediately, something like scales fell from Saul's eyes, and he regained his sight. Then he got up and was immersed;
