Tazria (Leviticus 14:16-20)

16 He is to dip his right finger in the oil that is in his left hand and sprinkle some of the oil with his finger seven times before *ADONAI*.

17 Then the *kohen* should dab some of the rest of the oil that is in his hand on the tip of the right ear of the one being cleansed, on the thumb of his right hand and on the big toe of his right foot, on top of the blood of the trespass offering.

Tazria (Leviticus 14:16-20)

18 From what remains of the oil that is in his hand, the *kohen* is to dab on the head of the one being cleansed. In this way the *kohen* will make atonement for him before *ADONAI*.

19 "The *kohen* should offer the sin offering and make atonement for the one being cleansed because of his uncleanness. Afterward he is to slaughter the burnt offering.

20 Then the *kohen* is to present the burnt offering along with the grain offering on the altar. So the *kohen* should make atonement for him, and he will be clean.
